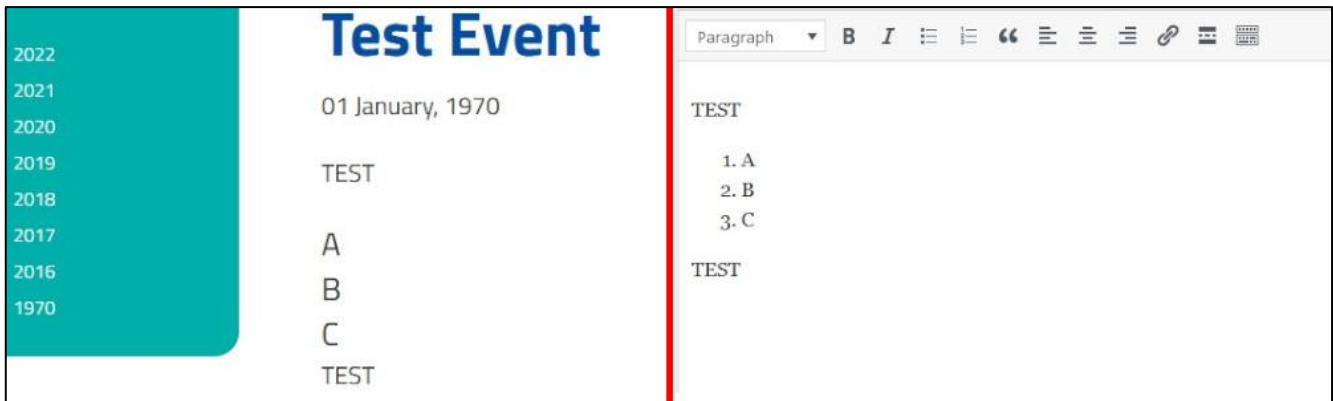


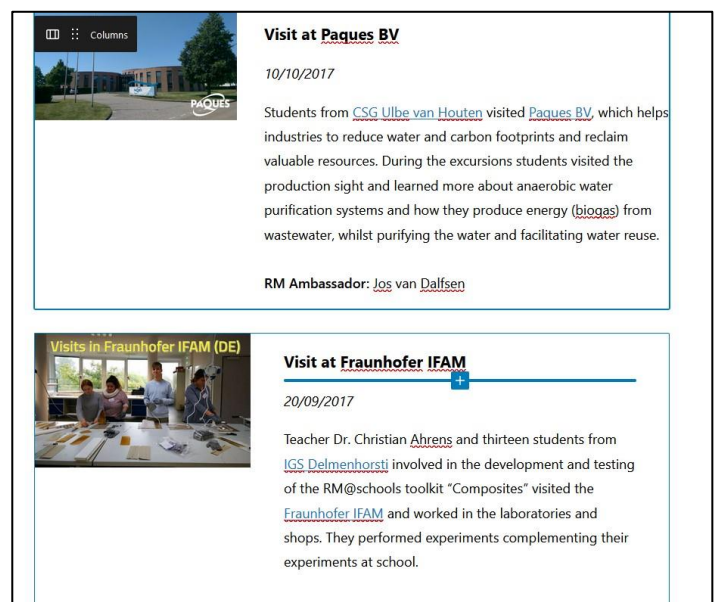
“Events” page formatting bug

In the “Event” pages, numbered lists are not rendered as such, but rather the text is given a different font/size. This doesn’t seem to be happening site-wide, but I can’t rule out it isn’t also happening in some other specific type of pages. “Students in Action” columns random bug

While working in the “Study Visits & Press Coverage” page (<https://rmschools-beta.n11r.eu/students-in-action/study-visits-press-coverage/>), I encountered a bug related to the stacking of Columns elements. For some reason, two separate sets of columns are being displayed one beside the other, rather than one after the other. I don’t think I did anything different when creating these two elements compared to any other, and I can make the issue stop if I add another element after the first set of Columns (like a Spacer); so I suppose for some reason these two Columns blocks, when immediately one after the other, are not being recognized as distinct elements, but instead the website is treating them as a single continuous set of columns.



I did not alter the situation any further, apart from a couple of quick tests, so that you can have a look at it yourselves and figure out if this might be a symptom of some deeper underlining issue.
